Questions and Answers

1. Are there any auditor reporting responsibilities to the Minister of Transport expected from the auditor that isn't outlined in the RFP?

The Port systems are continually under review with modifications being made as needed. We have commenced the implementation of a company-wide document management and storage system in 2018. The G/L will be remapped for 2019 to allow for an amended reporting structure, however there are no major changes to the basic systems anticipated.

The Port looks to continue diversification and growth along with renewal of assets. The Port's marina is a major asset renewal that has commenced in 2018.
