

## SUMMER STUDENT EMPLOYMENT

The Nanaimo Port Authority hires a number of summer students for employment during the months of May through September to provide additional coverage in the Wharfinger, Safety Patrol and Maintenance departments. Shifts vary and may include evening, early morning and weekend work depending upon schedules set up for each department.

Qualifying students must be registered for post secondary education in the fall of the year employed. Unfortunately, students who are completing their courses during the year of employment will not be considered.

Students will be selected based on their experience and qualifications for the available positions. Preference will be given to those students that meet prerequisites such as:

- Communication skills
- Pleasure Craft Operators Certificate (or similar)
- First aid/CPR
- Boating experience
- Public/customer service
- WorldHhost
- Cash handling experience
- Computer skills
- Maintenance/janitorial skills
- VHF certificate
- Ability to multitask
- Ability to work as a team member
- Valid Class 5 or 7 Driver's License

Students wishing to apply for summer employment should submit their resume no later than April 5th for consideration. Resumes received after April 5th may not be considered.
